1 NOVEMBER 1970 - MOORED PORT SIDE TO THE PIER AT INACTIVATION SITE, PIER 6, BERTH 62½, US NAVAL SHIPYARD, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA IN A MIST OF TWO MINESWEEPERS WITH STANDARD MOORING LINES DOUBLED. USS ADVANCE (MSO 510) MOORED OUTBOARD TO STARBOARD. RECEIVING MISCELLANEOUS SERVICES FROM THE PIER. SHIPS PRESENT INCLUDE UNITS OF THE US PACIFIC FLEET, US PACIFIC RESERVE FLEET, ALLIED NAVIES, MERCHANTMEN, AND VARIOUS SMALL CRAFT. SOPA IS COMINERAC AT THE US NAVAL STATION, LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA. CONDITION OF READINESS V AND MATERIAL CONDITION VOKE SET
