MEMORANDUM FOR GENERAL NORSTAD

SUBJECT: "JACK PINE" Plans (U)

1. The Ambassadorial Group in Washington has been considering possible actions the "CDR" or USSR may take in attempting to deny air access to Berlin. Possible counter-actions available to the Allied powers have also been discussed.

2. It is requested that you study urgently and make recommendations relative to expanding JACK PINE plans to include graduated counter-action against enemy airfields, AA and missile sites, and ground installations. It would be understood that any such counter-action would be the subject of a separate political decision to be taken at the time.
