## A. INTELLIGENCE

1. Enemy activity was increased since the last reporting period due to the start of the current offensive which began on 11 May 1969 with the shelling of the majority of military installations not only in Northern I Corps, but the entire area of South Vietnam. Reports indicated that enemy activity would be heavily increased on the night of 19 May 1969 in celebration of Ho Chi Minh's birthday. However, there were no major incidents that night as anticipated. Mining incidents were down over last month, however, latest intelligence reports indicate a VC guerrilla platoon working along Route #9 with the mission of mining and harassment. Agent reports indicate the enemy has intentions of infiltrating additional troops into South Vietnam with the purpose of reinforcing troops they already have there.

2. Existing "table-top" procedures have been steadily improving this month thus giving current personnel and incoming personnel into the S-2 Shop a more comprehensive understanding of S-2 functions.

OPERATIONS

C. OPERATIONS

1. General. During the month of May 1969, Company "A" (Rein), Company "B" (Rein), and Company "C" (Rein) remained in direct combat support of the 4th, 3d and 9th Marine Regiments respectively. The remainder of the Battalion was in general support of the 3d Marine Division.

2. General Combat Support.

a. A total of 1,498,520 meters of road were covered by 3d Engineer Battalion visual/deliberate route sweeps. The following road segments of routes 9, 561, and 558 were covered by regularly scheduled daily sweeps:

c. Company "A" performed the following general construction:

(1) Extensive drainage improvements for the 4th Marine Regiment COC at Vandegrift Combat Base.

d. Company "B" performed the following general construction:

- (1) Mess deck for Battalion 2/3
- (2) Stage for 3d Marine Regiment
- (3) Box construction for 3d Marine Regiment mess hall.

e. Company "C" performed the following general construction:

- (1) Engineer equipment support to the 11th Engineer Battalion for LSA construction at Vandegrift Combat Base.
- (2) Installed screen wire on Battalion 3/9 mess hall.
- (3) Completed the Hill 950 renovation project to include 12 - 8x8 bunkers, safe lanes through mine field; and installation

of a chain link fence to minimize potential of RPG rounds.

f. Engineer Support Company performed the following general construction:

- (1) 1 - TD18 tractor was utilized for 3 days digging new trash dumps and burying old dumps at C-4 and Ocean View.
- (2) 2 - TD18 tractors were employed in support of the 14th Engineer Battalion, USA, for the purpose of constructing a road from Bo Bang to Cua Viet.
- (3) Completed clearing the Quang Tri Combat Base ASP of all grass and/or combustible material as a fire preventive measure.
- (4) Committed 2 - TD18 tractors, 2 - 05100B scrapers, 3 - MRS 100 tractors, and 3 - H82 scrapers in support of LSA construction at Vandegrift Combat Base.

g. Surveyors from the Battalion Drafting and Surveying section completed a survey of the Quang Tri Combat Base ASP to determine the amount of space required for planned expansion.

### 3. Direct Combat Support.

a. The 3 engineer companies of the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to support the 3 infantry regiments of the Division as reported in the April Command Chronology. During the month of May the Battalion participated in all major operations of the 3d Marine Division to include Cameron Falls, Herkimer Mountain, Apache Snow, and Virginia Ridge.

b. Company "A" completed the following work on Fire Support Bases on Operation Herkimer Mountain:

- (1) Improved gun pits on FSB Neville utilizing 105 air compressor and "pavement buster".
- (2) Constructed FSB Hill 691 at YD 928442 consisting of 6 - 105 pits, 4 - 155 pits, 6 ammunition berms, 3 landing zones, 48 - 8x12 bunkers and 8 - 10x24 bunkers.

c. Company "C" completed the following work on Fire Support Bases during Operation Apache Snow:

- (1) Re-opened FSB Razor. 6 - 105 pits were improved and 2 ammunition berms constructed. The VIP helo pad was enlarged and 40x40' LSA constructed.
- (2) Constructed 2 new 105 pits, 6 ammunition berms, 2

trash pits, and 6 communications bunkers in improving FSB Erskine.

(3) Re-opened Fire Support Base Shepherd in direct support of Battalion 3/9 (OP CON 4th Marine Regiment) in Operation Cameron Falls.

(3) Company "B" completed construction of a 6,200 meter road from C-2 to Hill 162 to facilitate resupply of units operating in the Virginia Ridge AO.

(4) Normal road maintenance and dust suppression continued.

b. Field Fortifications. In addition to those bunkers constructed on Fire Support Bases, the 3d Engineer Battalion continued to assist 3d Marine Division units with materials and supervisory personnel in the construction and improvement of wire obstacles and bunkers.

1. First platoon of Company "A", 3d Engineer Battalion, reinforced by 3d Engineer Battalion case tractor personnel, provided direct support to the 4th Marine Regiment in the development of Fire Support Base Neville located at 827574 from 10 April to 1 May.

2. Engineer Task Organization:

1st Platoon, Company "A", 3d Engineer Battalion  
 One heavy equipment operator, 3d Engineer Battalion (VCB)

3. The Engineer Mission Assigned:

a. Provide engineer support as required in the development of Fire Support Base Neville, develop an external landing zone, three 8'x12' bunkers and one 10'x24' bunker for 4th Marine Regiment, improvement of the 5th and 6th gun pits, and one 8'x12' bunker for an executive bunker.

To accomplish the assigned mission, 1st Platoon (-) from Company "A" was charged with providing the required demolition support and the heavy equipment detachment of 3d Engineer Battalion located at Vandergrift Combat Base was tasked to provide a Case 450 tractor and operator to be heli-lifted into the job site when called for, and a 105 air compressor when called for.

## 7. Engineer Observations:

a. Having a artillery battery representative with a small working party to go with the engineer element has proven invaluable in the past. This was not done in the case of the operations up at Neville. The ranking man left behind was a 1/Cpl in communication. After three days of work, the engineer officer was forced to call back to the artillery S-3 to send out an artillery officer. After he arrived, work progressed to a satisfactory completion.

B. When building supplies arrived they came in such quantities that the area became over crowded. And all but a very few of the bundles were unmarked. It is recommended that a greater coordination between S-3 and S-4 take place in the future, and that all bundles of material are marked as to what they are for.

- 11 April 69: Received frag order to prepare 4 bunker sites for Regiment.
- 12 April 69: Engineer team lifted to Neville.
- 13 April 69: Sites for 4 bunkers of Regiment were selected and timber and trash were cleared.
- 14 April 69: Waited for air compressor and continue clearing sites.
- 15 April 69: Compressor was lifted to Neville and was dropped over side of hill.
- 16 April 69: Cleared by pick and shovel one 8'x12' bunker site for Regiment.
- 17 April 69: Cleared second 8'x12' bunker site for Regiment.
- 18 April 69: Waited for bunker materials. Received frag order to improve 5th and 6th gun pits, and improve lower Landing Zone for Artillery.
- 19 April 69: Waited for materials.
- 20 April 69: Tractor operator arrived on hill along with fuel for tractor.
- 21 April 69: Guns were lifted out and tractor was inserted. Two test shots were made to determine type of rock.
- 22 April 69: Demolition work on gun pits began in earnest 30% complete.
- 23 April 69: Continued work on pits 50% complete.
- 24 April 69: Continued work on pits 70% complete.
- 25 April 69: Gun pits 100% complete.
- 26 April 69: Started and completed one 10'x10' bunker for 2/4.
- 27 April 69: Started and completed lower Landing Zone, thanks to a working party from 60 mortars, also started and completed 12'x12' FDC for 81 mortars.
- 28 April 69: Finished odds and ends. Received one 8'x12' bunker from Green.
- 29 April 69: Received one 8'x12' bunker from Green. Used both as ammunition storage bunkers for Artillery.
- 30 April 69: Waited further word.
- 1 May 69: Project attempted, engineering team prepared to leave Neville.

1. Equipment Problem Areas. The major problem confronting this unit is chain saws in that there is a high percentage that are declined for the repair parts set listed in paragraph 10 b. The Battalion is up to 1/2 on chain saws at present approximately 30 chain saws are declined which is over 60% of our / allowances.
