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9. Mission Assigned

1st Battalion, 3d Marines occupies and controls assigned TAOR; defends MLR in assigned TAOR; defends NAM O Bridge (AT 927842) in coordination with RVNAF, conducts unilateral search and destroy operations in assigned TAOR; conducts aggressive combat/reconnaissance patrolling throughout assigned TAOR; prepared to conduct combined and coordinated operations with the RVANF within and beyond the boundaries of assigned TAOR; maintains one Rifle Company as Regimental Reserve for deployment as directed; conducts squad size patrol Red Beach area at least twice weekly; provides security for Esso POL terminal (AT 939863); provides security for construction site for LAAM Battalion on Hill 724 (AT 944917).

10. Background. Stabilization of the political situation in the area improved cooperation and coordination between USMC and Regional and Popular Force units and village officials in the area. The Combined Action Unit in HOA VINH has made excellent progress toward developing into an extremely effective tool for the task of effectively controlling the TAOR.

The only contact with VC within the TAOR was with small groups. A series of COUNTY FAIRS was conducted within the TAOR in order to assist the local government in establishing influence in the villages.

The 1st Battalion, 3d Marines(-) was under the operational control of the 9th Marines for Operation MACON 6-14 July 1966 as the month ended the 1st Battalion, 3d Marines(-) was under the operational control of Task Force Delta for Operation HASTINGS 15-31 July 1966.

e. Special Services: The special services activities were normal.

2. Administration

a. Personnel Accounting: No significant events

b. Awards: 1 Silver Star, 2 Bronze Stars, 1 Navy Commendation Medal and 10 Purple Heart Awards were received.

c. Promotions: During July 2 Staff Sergeants were appointed to Temporary Second Lieutenant, 4 were promoted to Gunnery Sergeant, 4 to Staff Sergeant, 39 to Corporal, 94 to Lance Corporal and 26 to Private First Class.

d. Postal: Postal services were normal. Mail was delivered to personnel that were participating in operations MACON and HASTINGS at least every other day.

e. Pay: A majority of the command was not paid on 15 July due to operational commitments. They will be paid upon their return to the TAOR.

f. Post Exchange: The exchange service is adequate. Catalogs and order blanks were received from the Post Exchange in El Toro and were distributed to the troops.

g. Legal and discipline: 8 Company Office Hours were held in July. One enlisted man was tried by General Court Martial and was sentenced to a Bad Conduct Discharge, confinement at hard labor for 1 year and forfeiture of all pay and allowances.

d. Significant trends during period - None

e. Enemy situation at end of period.

The battalion operating north of the TAOB is carried as the 51st (probable). It is estimated that the strength of this battalion is 250-350 men. One report indicates that the battalion has received many new replacements and it is probable that training is being conducted in the area north of the TAOB. The enemy can be expected to continue with small arms harassing and sniper fire, mining incidents and terrorist tactics during the month of August.

a. Objective. The objective of training conducted during July was the maintenance and improvement of the Battalion's capability to carry out its assigned mission.

b. Major Training Highlights. Three officers and five NCO's attended two, one half day periods of instruction on VC land mines and booby traps at the 3d Engineer Battalion. A contact team gave a series of lectures on VC land mines and booby traps to 25 replacements at the 1st Battalion, 3d Marines C.P.

Familiarization firing of individual and crew served weapons was conducted by all companies, in addition company level classes on general military subjects related to operations in Viet Nam.

d. Cantonment and Camp Facilities. All of the authorized bunkers have been received with the exception of one 8' X 8' and one 12' X 24'. Landing zone "Turkey" was oiled and work is in progress on the enlargement of the Dong Den LZ. The bunker material requested for fighting and living holes has not been received.

e. Transportation and Roads. Work was started on improving the access road into the Battalion Motor Pool. NamO Bridge was repaired during the month.

f. Fiscal. Operating under combat funding.

g. Water. The water point is providing ample water for using units, and experienced no mechanical difficulties.

h. Motor Transport. Motor Transport is operating normally. One M-422A1 is on deadline at FLSG for a transmission, and an M-170 ambulance has not been received for the one which was code X'd. Six trucks support the Battalion daily.

i. Embarkation. Embarkation data is current, and sufficient mount-out boxes are on hand.

Civil Affairs/Military Government/Community Relations

a. Significant activities

1. Civil Affairs activities have continued to increase during the month of July. It has been noted that the Vietnamese are beginning to take a greater interest in the improvement of their communities. As the Marines have shown that they are here to help, the villagers have donated more time and materials to the improvement of their area. Close contact was maintained with village officials and civic leaders.

2. In addition to Vietnamese treated by BAS on medevac runs and at the Pediatric Hospital, Company medical teams treated 2741 persons within the 1/3 taor.

b. Materials distributed

1. 975 pounds of food, 100 pounds of clothing, 9478 bars of soap, 150 pounds of toys, 200 pencils, books, etc. were distributed to needy Vietnamese during the month of July, with the bulk of the materials being distributed to the refugee hamlets.

c. Special Civil Affairs projects

1. The foot bridge in Hoa Vinh (AT899797) is now completed.
2. Work has been started on the market place in Hoa Thanh (AT906789). When finished this will aid the villagers of Hoa Thanh and Hoa Vinh.
3. The construction of the PF Barracks at Le My (AT899818) have been completed. The PF's are now living in the barracks.
4. The school at the New Life Hamlet (AT898772) has been completed. Two school teachers are being furnished by Hue Duc District. The school will open 1 August 1966.
5. 150 bags of cement and 75 sheets of tin were given to the Catholic Orphanage (AT905764) for construction of a dining room.
6. Thirty two 55 gallon drums have been distributed to the hamlet of Le My (AT897815) for use as containers for rice storage and trash receptacles.
7. The school building at Le My has been repainted.
8. Seven homes have now been completed in the Refugee Camp (AT897815). The homes are being constructed of ammo box material. Several more homes are presently under construction. Marines have helped the villagers with some of the actual construction.
9. Two schools are now presently in operation in Kim Lien AT925855 and one more will open on 7 August. Plans are presently being made to build an additional class room in Kim Lien. The schools presently in operation and the one opening 7 August can only handle up to the 3d

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grade. The additional class room will allow those students without money to further their education past the 3d grade.

10. 3 water wells have been constructed or repaired in the month of July and twenty four others will be repaired in the near future.

11. A cement deck was constructed in the Hoa Vinh (AT901795) meeting hall. Gravel and labor was donated by the villagers. Marines furnished three truck loads of sand.

12. A request has been submitted through Civil Affairs channels asking that the road from AT908784 to AT901817 be resurfaced.. If this is brought about the villagers in the Hoa Loc area and the refugee's will have a means of getting more gravel, lumber, produce, etc. to markets. Vietnamese vehicles do not want to travel this road as it is extremely hard on vehicles. If project is completed it will benefit eight hamlet and also the Marine Corps, as many government vehicles travel this road.

d. Apparent results of Civil Affairs program. An increase of planned projects being completed and a great improvement in the attitude of the villagers toward self help projects has been noted in the past month. It is felt that this is due to the Marines learning to go through the village officials on all matters concerning their areas. Close cooperation between Marine personnel and village officials continues to improve as they learn to work together.
